	<p><b>CAFE Distinguished Service Award</b> National recognition for individuals who have given distinguished service in terms of dedication and leadership, for at least 10 years of service, in program development, facilities development and promoting the best interests of the exhibition. The award is designed to recognize individuals who have made a significant contribution to a particular fair or exhibition.</p>
	<p><b>CAFE Order of Merit</b> National recognition for companies or organizations who have given outstanding service, for a minimum of five years, in the form of services, sponsorships, financial aid and promoted the best interests of the exhibition. Designed to recognize companies and organizations who have made a significant contribution to a particular fair or exhibition.</p>
	<p><b>Northlands Leader of Tomorrow Award</b> Recognizes the outstanding contributions of the volunteer, involved in Northlands volunteer committees and programs, who is 30 years of age and under.</p>
	<p><b>Northlands Soaring Out of the Gate Award</b> This award recognizes an individual who goes far above and beyond the normal performance of a volunteer in their first year in a program or event in which they have never volunteered before. Must have less than 12 months of volunteering in a program they have not tried before.</p>
	<p><b>Northlands Volunteer Award of Merit</b> This award recognizes an individual providing meritorious volunteer service. No length of service requirement.</p>
	<p><b>Northlands 25-Year Roll of Honour</b> Presented to individuals, companies or community organizations who, because of their involvement with Northlands over a period of not less than 25 years, have contributed significantly not only to Northlands but to the community of north-central Alberta.</p>
	<p><b>Northlands Ambassador Award</b> Presented to an individual or organization in recognition of their outstanding efforts not only to Northlands but to the City of Edmonton and north-central Alberta.  Recipients are not necessarily selected each year.</p>
	<p><b>Northlands Achievement Award</b> Presented to individuals who have, over a period of not less than 10 years, provided meritorious service to Northlands Signature Events. May include suppliers, contributors and consultants.</p>
	<p><b>Northlands Community Spirit Award</b> This award is designed to recognize companies and organizations that have made a significant contribution to Northlands Signature Events. The award provides recognition to companies or organizations that have given outstanding service in the form of services, sponsorships, financial aid, and promoting the best interests of the fair.</p>
	<p><b>WFA Blue Ribbon Award</b> Presented by the WFA in an effort to recognize and honour those individuals or groups who have provided outstanding support to the fair and exhibition industry. Recipients are those who have provided educational services including former directors.</p>
